

PROCLAMATION AND NOTICE OF ELECTION  
LARAMIE COUNTY FIRE AUTHORITY  
BOND ELECTION – NOV 7, 2023  
LARAMIE COUNTY, WYOMING

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a bond election is to be held in Laramie County Fire Authority district, State of Wyoming, on Tuesday, November 7, 2023.

Any qualified registered elector in the district shall be entitled to vote on this question in person or by absentee ballot. Residents of Laramie County Fire Authority district who will be at least eighteen (18) years of age on or before November 7, 2023, and if not registered, are encouraged to register and vote. Acceptable identification is required. Residents may register at the office of the Laramie County Clerk or at the polls on Election Day. Absentee voting begins October 10, 2023, and ends November 6, 2023.

The polls will open at 7:00 a.m. on November 7, 2023, and will remain open until 7:00 p.m. on that date. The polling place will be located at:

Laramie County Fire Authority (the "District") proposes to purchase fire trucks and firefighting equipment for its fire stations, and to make needed improvements to its existing fire stations. The board of directors of the District has determined that the upgrades to the firefighting equipment and the station improvements are necessary to adequately serve the fire protection and public safety needs of the residents of the District.

To pay for the costs associated with the equipment purchases and station improvements, the District requests the authority to issue general obligation bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$5,900,000 bearing a maximum rate or rates of interest not to exceed 5.75% per annum and to mature within 5.50 years of their respective dates. The bonds will be payable from ad valorem property taxes levied against all taxable property in the District in amounts sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds in each year, and the bonds would be sold on such terms and conditions as the District may determine. The tax will expire when the bonds have been fully paid.

Shall the District be authorized to issue such bonds?

Any qualified registered elector may vote by absentee ballot beginning twenty-eight (28) days before the election. Only a qualified registered elector may receive an absentee ballot by requesting one by telephone or in writing. To request an absentee ballot, call (307) 633-4242. Written requests may be emailed to [election@laramiecountywy.gov](mailto:election@laramiecountywy.gov) or by mail to Elections, Laramie County Clerk, 309 W 20th St., Cheyenne, WY 82001. A written request must contain your full legal name, date of birth, residence and mailing address (if different), and a statement that the applicant is entitled to vote in the election. Absentee ballots cannot be requested on the day of the election. Absentee ballots must be received in the Clerk's office not later than 5:00 p.m. on Election Day.
