Come to the County Clerk's voter drop in event

Laramie County Library, October 10, 5:30 – 7:00 pm.

The Laramie County Clerk, in conjunction with the Cheyenne League of Women Voters, is hosting a voter 'drop in' event at the Laramie County Library where the public can get information on voter registration and voting, fill out a registration application, update their registration, and learn more about how to participate in the 2020 elections .

Persons wishing to register need to bring their Wyoming driver's license or other government issued identification, if they do not have a Wyoming license. To register and vote, you must be a U.S. citizen, resident of Laramie County, age 18 by Election Day, and voting rights restored if convicted of a felony.

The voter drop in event takes place Thursday, Oct. 10, 5:30 to 7:30 p.m., 2200 Pioneer Avenue.
