#### **Absentee and early voting for November's tax election starts Sept. 17**

#### **Voters can request absentee ballots now**

Absentee and early voting for Laramie County's Nov. 2 election on the 1% specific purpose sales and use tax (6th penny) begins Sept. 17. Voters will consider 14 ballot propositions, grouped into the categories of public safety, roads, infrastructure, and community enhancements. Voters may vote for or against each proposition and a proposition must receive a majority of votes cast on it to be approved.

Laramie County Clerk Debra Lee said any registered voter can request an absentee ballot that will be mailed to their home.

"Absentee voting has become increasing popular as a convenient way of voting at home and it's as simple as a visit, phone call or email to our office – but voters must request them each year," said Lee.

Registered voters can call 633-4242 or email [election@laramiecountyclerk.com](mailto:election@laramiecountyclerk.com) to request a ballot. Voters must provide their name, date of birth, residence and mailing address. Lee said ballots will be mailed starting Sept. 17 to those who have requested them.
