Monday, Oct. 18, is the last day to register to vote *before* the Nov. 2 One Percent Specific Purpose Sales and Use Tax (6th penny) Election, but voters can still register at the polls

Monday, Oct. 18, is the deadline to register to vote ahead of the Nov. 2 One Percent Specific Purpose Sales and Use Tax (6th penny) Election. Those who miss the registration deadline, however, can still register *and* cast their ballot early or at the polls on Election Day.

Laramie County Clerk Debra Lee said the purpose of the voter registration deadline is to give the Clerk's office time to prepare voter lists for the coming election.

New registrants are required to produce their Wyoming driver's license. If they do not have a Wyoming license, another government-issued photo I.D. such as the Wyoming identification card, military ID, driver's license from another state, tribal ID, or U.S. passport may be used for registration. Acceptable identification required for voting includes driver's license, state-issued identification card, tribal ID, U.S. military card, valid U.S. passport, Wyoming university, community college or public school ID, or valid Medicare or Medicaid card.
