

**Laramie County Clerk update on voting in the 1% specific purpose sales and use tax (6<sup>th</sup> penny) election as of Mon., Nov. 1 (last day of early voting)**

Today marked the end of early voting for Laramie County's 6<sup>th</sup> penny election and the highest one-day total since the start of early voting for this election. More than 600 voters braved the cold weather today to vote in the atrium of the Laramie County Governmental Complex.

County Clerk Debra Lee said voters had no problems complying with the new voter ID law that requires voters to present an acceptable ID prior to voting.

Below are totals as of 5 p.m. Nov. 1:

Total early voters: 4282

Absentee ballots received in the Clerk's office: 2446

Total number of persons voting (early and absentee): 6728

Absentee ballots not yet received in the Clerk's office: 422

Absentee voters have until 7:00 p.m. on Election night (Nov. 2) to return their ballots to the Clerk's office. Voters are encouraged to use the ballot drop box, located next to the County building, Carey Ave between 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> St. or return their ballot to the office in person.

On Election Day, Tues., Nov. 2, voters can cast their ballot at any one of seven vote centers from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.:
