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The Laramie County 5th Penny, a 1% General Excise Tax, in 1977. The tax has been continuously renewed since. The current term will expire on December 31, 2026 and the question of renewal will appear on the November 3, 2026 ballot. 5th penny supports general government operations and services, unlike 6th Penny which funds specific projects. Funding is divided into the following groups: Public Works (70% Funding), Health/Welfare (5.5% Funding), Library (10% Funding), Sheriff's Office (5.5%), Fire District Equipment (2.5%), Recreation Board (1%), General Government (3%), in addition to Conservation and Development (2.5%) .
