

**LARAMIE COUNTY PRIMARY ELECTION PROCLAMATION**

The Clerk of Laramie County, in accordance with the Secretary of State, and as directed by Federal and State mandates, proclaims that August 20, 2024 is the date of the Primary Election to fill various and prescribed United States, State of Wyoming, District, Laramie County, City of Cheyenne, and Town of Pine Bluffs public offices.

All eligible residents of Laramie County who are U.S. citizens, age 18 or older on or before August 20, 2024, who have not registered to vote are encouraged to do so on or before August 5, 2024 and participate in this election. Acceptable identification is required to register and to vote. Citizens eligible to register and vote may do so at the polls on Election Day. Early/absentee voting begins July 23, 2024 and ends August 19, 2024. Absentee ballots mailed to voters must be returned to the Clerk’s office not later than 7 p.m. on August 20, 2024.

Each political party in each precinct shall elect one (1) committeeman and one (1) committeewoman for each two hundred fifty (250) votes, or a major fraction thereof, cast for the party’s candidate for representative in congress in the last general election, but provided that no precinct shall be entitled to less than one (1) precinct committeeman and precinct committeewoman. If a precinct boundary line is changed for any reason, the County Commissioners shall determine the number of precinct committeemen and committeewomen to which the affected precinct is entitled. The term of office for all precinct committeemen and committeewoman shall begin on the first Monday in January of the year following their election. W.S. 22-4-101 (e). Republicans have 81 precinct pairs. Democrats have 49 precinct pairs.

Voters can go to any vote center in the county. Vote Centers open at 7 a.m. on August 20, 2024, and remain open until 7 p.m. on that date. The Vote Centers are:
