INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS

TO VOTE, DARKEN THE OVAL TO THE LEFT OF YOUR CHOICE LIKE THIS : ● If you tear, deface or wrongfully mark this ballot, return it to the election official.

VOTE BOTH SIDES

There are six (6) propositions proposed for funding through a 1% Specific Purpose Sales and Use Tax. Each proposition stands alone. You may vote for or against each proposition. Each proposition must receive a majority of votes cast on that proposition to be approved.

Shall Laramie County be authorized to impose an additional one percent (1%) Specific Purpose Sales and Use Tax, within Laramie County, to be used and applied for funding the planning, engineering, construction, remodeling, furnishing, equipping, supplying (including maintenance equipment), maintaining, acquisition and improvement of land (if necessary) and, to the extent necessary and allowed by law, the pledge to or payment of operation and maintenance, debt service and/or lease payments thereon, in the specified amounts and for the specified purposes provided below:

PROPOSITION 1

To collect a total \$4,410,000.00 and interest earned thereon for public safety projects:

- A. \$1,717,000.00 to the City of Cheyenne for in-car computers and in-car video camera systems for the Cheyenne Police Department;
- B. \$278,000.00 to Laramie County for in-car computers and in-car video camera systems for the Laramie County Sheriff's Department;
- C. \$5,000.00 to the Town of Pine Bluffs for in-car computers and in-car video camera systems for the Pine Bluffs Police Department;
- D. \$510,000.00 to the City of Cheyenne for first responders equipment and thermal imagers for the Cheyenne Fire Department;
- E. \$890,000.00 to the Laramie County Fire Districts for first responders equipment and thermal imagers;
- F. \$500,000.00 to Laramie County for additional early warning sirens;
- G. \$35,000.00 to the Town of Pine Bluffs for a police vehicle and equipment; and
- H. \$475,000.00 to assist the Cheyenne Airport in improving the safety of its runways.

To collect a total of \$11,000,000.00 and interest earned thereon for a public transportation project:

- A. \$11,000,000.00 to the City of Cheyenne for improvements to the Norris Viaduct.

To collect a total of \$4,500,000.00 and interest earned thereon for the Greater Cheyenne Greenway System:

- A. \$4,500,000.00 to the City of Cheyenne for an extension of the Greater Cheyenne Greenway from East Cheyenne to the Norris Viaduct.

PROPOSITION 4

To collect a total of \$3,050,000.00 and interest earned thereon for quality of life projects:

- A. \$2,000,000.00 to the City of Cheyenne for development of South Cheyenne Park on property located east and south of Parsley Blvd.;
- B. \$1,000,000.00 to the City of Cheyenne for the implementation Lions Park Master Plan Infrastructure; and
- C. \$50,000.00 to the Town of Pine Bluffs for playground equipment for the Pine Bluffs Community Center and for covered bleachers at the Pine Bluffs Town Arena;

PROPOSITION 5

To collect a total of \$8,042,325.00 and interest earned thereon for Public Health and Welfare Projects:

- A. \$5,000,000.00 to the City of Cheyenne for improvements to the Crow Creek and Dry Creek Wastewater Treatment Plants;
- B. \$1,180,000.00 to the Town of Pine Bluffs to upgrade the Town electrical system, to install automated meters and reading system and to install concrete on 6th Street between Plum Street and Parsons Street;
- C. \$310,000.00 to the Town of Albin for a new heating and cooling system at the Albin Community Center;
- D. \$125,000.00 to the Town of Albin to replace water meters and repair Albin's small water tower;
- E. \$1,100,000.00 to the Town of Burns for the implementation of Phase II of the Storm Water Drainage System, and installation of Sewer lines along Main Street; and
- F. \$327,325.00 to the Eastern Laramie County Solid Waste Disposal District to purchase a Scraper.

To collect a total of \$26,900,000.00 and interest earned thereon for the Laramie County Library System:

- A. \$26,900,000.00 for a new central library facility; to be located in an area North of 22nd Street, South of 23rd Street, West of Pioneer Avenue and East of O'Neil Avenue in the City of Cheyenne, the improvement and equipping of the Pine Bluffs Branch Library, and the acquisition of a bookmobile.
