LARAMIE COUNTY CLERK HOSTS VOTER REGISTRATION POP-UP EVENT NOV. 12

LARAMIE COUNTY, WY- The Laramie County Clerk's office is holding a voter registration popup event on Weds., Nov. 12, at the Laramie County Senior Activity Center, 4100 E Pershing Blvd. The event takes place in the center's conference room, from 10:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Staff from the Clerk's election office will be on hand to register new voters, confirm or update registration information, and answer questions about registration and voting. The requirements to register are: U.S. citizen, resident of Laramie County, age 18 by the day of the election, not adjudicated mentally incompetent, and Wyoming voting rights restored if convicted of a felony.

"Wyoming has new laws requiring registrants to provide proof of citizenship and residency. We want our voters to be prepared before they go to the polls in 2026 by registering or updating their information now. Registration is the first step to participation," said County Clerk Debra Lee.

Lee said the Wyoming driver's license or Wyoming ID are the gold standard documents and satisfy most if not all of the requirements for proof of citizenship and residency. If a person does not have a valid Wyoming license or ID, other government-issued identification, such as a driver's license from another state, U.S. passport, or military ID are accepted. However, Lee noted that if the document does not list a Wyoming address or does not meet the proof of citizenship requirement, other documents may be required. Wyoming law also requires persons who do not have a Wyoming driver's license to provide the last four digits of their social security number at the time of registration. Those without a Wyoming license or ID can register by producing documents from among the list of provided on the Secretary of State's website at https://sos.wyo.gov/Elections/State/RegisteringToVote.aspx

"Wyoming is one of the few states without online registration, and we know it can be difficult for people to come to our office, so we are pleased to make this nonpartisan opportunity available at the Senior Center," said Lee.

This is the second registration event the Clerk's office has sponsored in preparation for next year's elections. On Sept. 16, National Voter Registration Day, the office held a registration event and mock election at the Laramie County Library.
