### Primary Election Sample Ballots Available

**LARAMIE COUNTY, WY-** Wyoming's Primary Election is Aug. 18 and early and absentee voting begins July 21. Voters can now access their Laramie County Primary Election sample ballots online or request one in the County Clerk's election office, located in the Laramie County Governmental Complex, 309 W 20<sup>th</sup> St., Suite 1500.

Voters can view and print their ballot by visiting the Clerk's Election page at [www.laramiecountywy.gov](http://www.laramiecountywy.gov) – Ballot Lookup or use the QR code, entering their address, and selecting their political party affiliation.



County Clerk Debra Lee said there are three types of ballots for the Primary Election—Democratic, Republican, and nonpartisan. Because Wyoming has a closed Primary election, voters will receive a ballot matching the party they selected when registering to vote. All voters will receive ballots containing the Optional 1% Specific Purpose (6<sup>th</sup> Penny) Ballot Propositions.

Absentee ballots for military and overseas voters were mailed July 2. Ballots for all other voters who have requested them will be mailed on July 21. Lee reminds voters who want to vote at home to request their absentee ballots as soon as possible by providing their name, date of birth, residence and mailing address, the political party with which they are registered, the elections for which they want ballots (Primary/General) and contact information. Requests are accepted by telephone, mail, or email [election@laramiecountywy.gov](mailto:election@laramiecountywy.gov) (Subject: Absentee *Voter Name*).

Early voting launches July 21 in the atrium of the Laramie County Governmental Complex and ends Aug. 17. Hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, except for county holidays. Voters are reminded to bring their Wyoming driver's license or other accepted government-issued identification.
