The Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) is a capabilities and performance-based exercise program. The intent of HSEEP is to provide common exercise policy and program guidance capable of constituting a national standard for all exercises. HSEEP includes consistent terminology that can be used by all exercise planners, regardless of the nature and composition of their sponsoring agency or organization.

The HSEEP Training Course is an intermediate level course designed to provide a set of guiding principles which incorporates standard exercise methodology and best practices. Throughout the course, participants will learn about exercise-related topics including program management, design and development, conduct, evaluation, and improvement planning. The HSEEP Training Course is an interactive course that allows participants to share personal lessons learned and best practices while gaining practical experience in developing a consistent exercise program. In addition to the instructor-led course presentations, the course includes small group activities, videos, and group discussions.

The intended audience for this training are those involved in exercise planning, program management, design and development, conduct, evaluation, and improvement planning of exercises.
