General Election Day

Interested in Becoming a Poll Worker?

Please contact our office to submit an application. Poll workers must attend a training course prior to serving. Students who are U.S. citizens age 16 or older and have parental permission can be poll workers.

FAQs

Q: What do I need to bring with me when I go to vote?

A: You must present an acceptable form of ID when voting early or at the polls.

Q: Where do I go to vote on Election Day?

A: Visit our website for a complete list of vote centers. You may vote at any location from 7 am to 7 pm.

Q: How do I know what district I'm in?

A: Enter your address on our Precinct and Voter Info Interactive Map on our website. During an election, your sample ballot will be available to view or print.

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Voter Registration Qualifications

- Be at least 18 years of age on or before Election Day
- Be a United States citizen
- Be a bona fide resident of Wyoming for not less than 30 days before the date of the election
- Not convicted of a felony, or if convicted, has had Wyoming voting rights restored
- Not be adjudicated mentally incompetent

Proof of Identity

Provide any one of the following:

- Unexpired, valid WY driver's license or WY ID card
- Tribal ID card
- Valid U.S. passport
- Unexpired, valid out-of-state driver's license or ID card
- WY school ID card with legal name
- U.S. military card

*If any of the documents above list a Wyoming address, said documentation shall also constitute proof of Wyoming residence.

Proof of U.S. Citizenship

Provide any one of the following:

- Valid WY driver's license or WY ID card
- Valid tribal ID card
- Valid out-of-state driver's license or ID card (must be REAL ID compliant)
- Valid U.S. passport
- Certificate of U.S. Citizenship
- Certificate of Naturalization
- U.S. military draft record
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad
- Original or certified copy of birth certificate

Proof of Residency

The following items must be current and dated within 90 days:

- Utility bill
- Bank statement
- Paycheck or pay stub
- Mortgage statement
- WY student housing verification form
- Any other government document showing your name and address

The following items must be dated within 1 year:

- Residential lease
- Contract or intake document from a residential care facility
- WY property tax bill or receipt
- WY hunting or fishing license
- WY vehicle registration
- Communication on letterhead from a public or private social service agency verifying the applicant is homeless and attesting to the applicant's residence for registration purposes

*If you do not have any of the documents above, proof of residence may be established by a signed attestation that you are a bona fide resident of Wyoming. The attestation shall be subject to verification by the County Clerk.

Voter ID

Wyoming voters are required to show an acceptable form of identification when voting in person. Any one of the following is accepted:

- WY driver's license or WY ID card
- Tribal ID card
- Valid U.S. passport
- U.S. military card
- Out-of-state driver's license or ID card
- WY school ID card
- Valid Medicare insurance card
- Valid Medicaid insurance card
- WY concealed firearm permit

How to Get an Absentee Ballot

Registered voters can request an absentee ballot at any time during an election year except on the day of the election. There are three ways to submit your request:

With your request, you must also provide your full name, date of birth, your residential and mailing addresses, contact number, and for the primary election, your political party affiliation.

Return your voted ballot by mail, deliver it to our office, or use the secured ballot drop box located outside our office building.

Making Changes to Your Voter Registration

To update your name or address on your voter registration, bring an acceptable form of identification to our office at any time, except during early voting or on Election Day when you will make those changes at the polls.

For a primary election, voters can change their party affiliation any time before the first day of candidate filing. For a general election, a voter may change party affiliation at our office not less than 14 days before Election Day or at the polls during early voting or on Election Day. An ID and signature are required to make this change.
